To transform them into materials for different activities via different organised guiding tours, landscaping and conservation activities, mountain lab camps and mine festivals, etc. Ultimately, to convey the importance and value of the history and culture of the mining village community and related landscapes to the Public, to achieve the goal of restoring the unique living culture of the mining village community.</p>
