	core conservation area for wildlife during the construction phase
	of Nature Park. After the establishment of the Nature Park, HSH
	is also important to enhance and supplement the conservation
	value of entire priority site. With the collaboration with
	landowners, tenant farmers and local communities, this project
	will continue to focus on birds, amphibians and landscape
	conservation by implementing various habitat management
	measures in the agro-ecosystem as well as promoting the
	concept of eco-agriculture. Education activities will be explored
	and developed in the HSH area to raise public awareness on the
	significance of local agriculture, wetland conservation and
	farmland ecology in Hong Kong.
