

## **Annual Work Report of the Energy Advisory Committee for the Period from 1 January to 31 December 2023**

### **I. Terms of Reference of the Energy Advisory Committee**

The Energy Advisory Committee (“EnAC”) was set up in July 1996 to advise the Government on energy policy, including policy matters concerning energy supply and demand, energy conservation and efficiency, and other related matters referred to it by the Government.

### **II. Membership of the Energy Advisory Committee**

EnAC is chaired by a non-official. It comprises non-official members from different sectors of the community, and official members from the Environment and Ecology Bureau and the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department. III Major Activities of the Energy Advisory Committee during the Period from 1 January to 31 December 2023

(1) Meeting on 19 May 2023

*2023 Interim Review of the Scheme of Control Agreements with the Two Power Companies*

The Government invited EnAC's views on the interim review of the Scheme of Control Agreements conducted by the Government with the two power companies (i.e. CLP Power Hong Kong Limited and The Hongkong Electric Company, Limited, collectively referred to as "the two power companies") in 2023.

(2) Meeting on 28 November 2023

*2024-28 Development Plan and 2024 Tariff Review, and 2023 Interim Review of the Scheme of Control Agreements*

The two power companies and the Government briefed members on the 2024-28 Development Plan and tariff proposals for 2024, and the outcome of the 2023 Interim Review of the Scheme of Control Agreements respectively. Members discussed the issues concerned.
