

# **Annual Work Report of the Energy Advisory Committee for the Period from 1 January to 31 December 2025**

## **I. Terms of Reference of the Energy Advisory Committee**

The Energy Advisory Committee (“EnAC”) was set up in July 1996 to advise the Government on energy policy, including policy matters concerning energy supply and demand, energy conservation and efficiency, and other related matters referred to it by the Government.

## **II. Membership of the Energy Advisory Committee**

EnAC is chaired by a non-official, with another non-official as Deputy Chairman. It comprises non-official members from different sectors of the community, and official members from the Environment and Ecology Bureau and the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department. **III Major Activities of the Energy Advisory Committee during the Period from 1 January to 31 December 2025**

**(1) Meeting on 15 July 2025**

**Measures by the two power companies on improving the resilience of their grids against extreme weather**

CLP Power Hong Kong Limited and The Hongkong Electric Company Limited (hereby referred as “the two power companies”) briefed Members on measures on improving the resilience of their grids against extreme weather. Members expressed views on the measures.

**Buildings Energy Efficiency Regime in Hong Kong**

The Government briefed members on the latest development of the buildings energy efficiency regime in Hong Kong, including energy saving measures in government, commercial and residential buildings. Members expressed views on the issues concerned.

(2) Meeting on 1 September 2025

*Pre-2026 Tariff Adjustment Presentation*

The two power companies provided Members with updates on their operations, including their reliability and environmental performance, fuel price trends, resilience work against extreme weather conditions and future outlook, etc. Members offered their views to the two power companies.

(3) Meeting on 25 November 2025

*2026 Tariff Adjustment*

The two power companies briefed Members the tariff adjustment for 2026. Members discussed the issues concerned.
